In 2016, the Illinois Children's Justice Taskforce designated Pediatric Child Abuse and Neglect Medical Centers of Excellence throughout Illinois. The concept of Medical Centers of Excellence is based on program standards established nationally by the Children's Hospital Association. 

MPEEC was established in 2000 to provide a real time medically informed coordinated interagency evaluation of children reported for medically based allegations where child abuse medical expertise is required. Unique to the MPEEC program is that there is a mandatory population of children who through real time referral by DCFS receive this interagency ongoing evaluation culminating in a final comprehensive written MPEEC report. As of 2021, the following children's hospitals are members of MPEEC: Comer, Advocate, Loyola and Rush Children's Hospitals. MPEEC central administration is located at University of Chicago. MPEEC also provides expert case review to DCFS through an intake referral process for all allegations. MPEEC provides quarterly trainings to DCFS and the community and lastly MPEEC Medical Leadership meets monthly for programmatic needs and a venue for peer review.
